## SPEAKER: Dr. Jason Fogler



Jason Fogler, M.A., Ph.D. is an Assistant Professor of Pediatrics and Psychiatry at Harvard Medical School and a staff psychologist in the Division of Developmental Medicine at Boston Children's Hospital. He serves on a team devoted to developmental trauma in children who have been adopted (domestically & internationally), asylum-seeking, or in the foster care system -- many of whom have significant co-occurring disabilities. He has published peer-reviewed journal articles and co-edited two books on this topic: Trauma Therapy in Context: The Science & Craft of Evidence-Based Practice (2012; APA Publications) and Trauma, Autism, and Neurodevelopmental Disorders: Integrating Research, Practice, & Policy (2018; SpringerNature).
